



Your new hearing aid

1. Your hearing aid

- You have a new hearing aid
- Your hearing aid will help you to hear better
- The more you use your aid, the more it will help you
- It may take a bit of time to get used to it


2. When to use your aid

- Use it every day
- Get washed and dressed and then put your hearing aid in.
- Keep it in your ear as long as possible
- You must keep your hearing aid dry. Take it out before you shower or wash your hair or go for a swim.
- Take your hearing aid out before you go to bed
- Keep it in the box to keep it safe

3. How to look after your hearing aid

- Check to see that the aid is working before you put it in your ear (see leaflet: "Is the hearing aid working?")
- Wipe the hearing aid with a damp tissue or cloth every time you take it out
- Wash the ear mould at least twice a week or more often if it looks dirty. (see leaflet: "Cleaning the ear mould")
- Every 4 months the aid will need to have a new tube fitted. Take the aid to the hospital or your hearing aid clinic
- If you are not wearing your hearing aid put it in the box to keep it safe
